

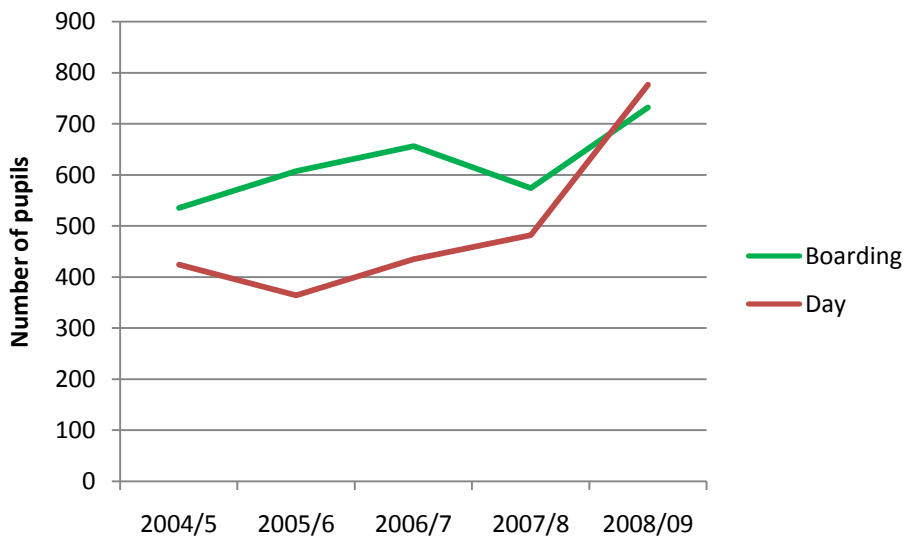
## International Pupils in SCIS Schools 2008

In September 2008 there was a total of 1,508 international pupils in SCIS schools. Of these, 51% were day pupils and 49% were boarders. Table 1 shows trends in international pupil numbers since 2004.

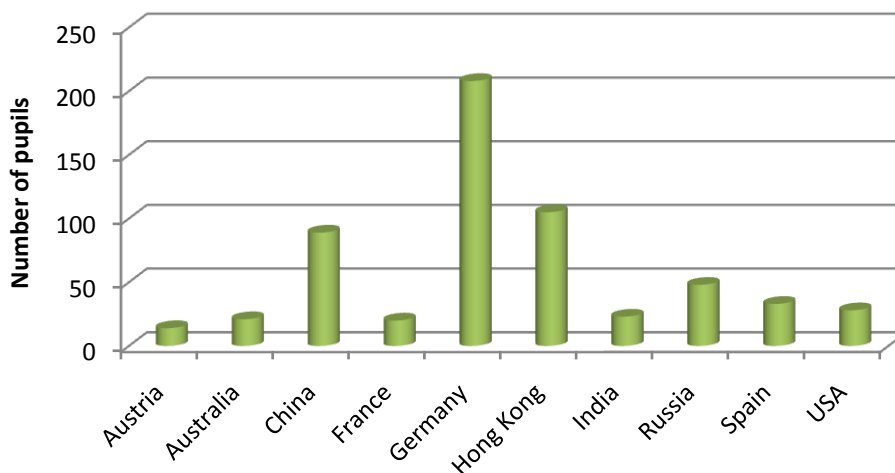
**Chart 1: Number of international pupils in SCIS schools by mode of attendance 2004-08**



### Boarding Pupils from Around the World

In September 2008 there were 732 international boarding pupils in SCIS schools. 80% were from the 10 countries shown in Chart 2 while the remaining 20% were from 44 countries worldwide.

## U.K. and International Boarding Pupils

Overall, the number of boarding pupils in SCIS schools has remained stable with minor fluctuations each year. The proportion of boarding pupils from overseas has fluctuated between 15% in 2004 and 21% in 2008 as illustrated in Table 2.

## Day Pupils with Non-British Passports

In September 2008 the reported number of day pupils from overseas (i.e. non-British passport holders) was 776, representing 51% of international pupils in SCIS schools<sup>1</sup> and 3% of all day pupils.
