



Most independent schools in Scotland follow the Scottish curriculum and exams are awarded by the Scottish Qualifications Authority (SQA). Four schools now offer the International Baccalaureate (IB) and others are considering its merits. Some schools, usually the boarding schools, offer A levels while a few schools offer a combination of the Scottish and English qualifications.
